As we celebrate the two-year Anniversary of the highly anticipated opening of Jupiter Medical Center's Johnny and Terry Gray Surgical Institute, we remain so grateful for your generous philanthropic support.

We are excited to share how that support has enabled Jupiter Medical Center to allow for more procedures, complex cases and cutting-edge care and invest in the long-term health of our growing community.

The 90,000-square-foot facility, featuring 16 smart operating rooms, two hybrid suites, and a cutting-edge sterilization center, has dramatically increased surgical capacity and elevated patient care at Jupiter Medical Center.

Digitally integrated "smart" operating rooms give surgeons immediate access to imaging and patient data, while hybrid surgical suites allow teams to shift seamlessly between minimally invasive and open procedures, reducing risk and accelerating recovery. Designed to serve more than 15,000 surgical cases each year, the Institute represents a major leap forward in access to world-class surgical care.



10,395 Surgeries Performed

Jupiter Medical Center ended the year with Patient Satisfaction scores at 94 percent and our volumes increased an average of 5 percent from the previous year with 10,395 surgeries performed

Orthopedic Surgery

The Anderson Family Orthopedic & Spine Center of Excellence offers a vast array of orthopedic and spine procedures. Our surgeons utilize the Makoplasty SmartRobotics™ Surgery System for partial and total knee replacements and total hip replacements, The VELYS™ Robotic-Assisted Solution for knee replacement, and the CORI Surgical System with handheld robotics, image-agnostic smart mapping to register 3D models of the joint in surgery, real-time planning for personalized surgery, handheld precision milling and intra-operative gap balancing for partial and total knee replacements. Additional technology includes the Hana® Table which was designed specifically for anterior hip replacement resulting in less pain and faster recovery for patients.

Cardiovascular Surgery

The Robson Heart & Vascular Institute provides minimally invasive to complex open-heart surgeries including coronary bypass surgery, valve replacement and more. For complex cardiac conditions, our team includes highly experienced open-heart surgeons giving patients the best possible outcomes and shorter recovery times.

Surgical Oncology

The Anderson Family Cancer Institute's team of surgical oncologists are experts in the surgical treatment of a variety of cancers, including breast, lung, gastrointestinal, liver/pancreas and gynecologic, using the most advanced technology available including minimally invasive and robotic surgery.

Pediatric Surgery

Our pediatric surgeons know that our littlest patients need specialized care. Specifically designed for children, the De George Pediatric Unit features two state-of-the-art pediatric operating rooms and offers services including general surgery, ENT surgery, gastrointestinal (GI) procedures, orthopedic surgery, plastic surgery and more.

Cutting Edge Technology

Jupiter Medical Center is proud to have one of the leading robotic surgery programs in the nation. Equipped with the latest surgical technology, six da Vinci® robotic-assisted surgical systems, including the da Vinci 5. As leaders in the field of robotic surgery, our highly specialized surgeons have the expertise to perform a wide spectrum of procedures with greater precision and increased vision.



Patients are increasingly recognizing the benefits of robotic precision in knee and hip replacements, and this same level of accuracy is now available at JMC for shoulder surgeries, like the one being performed by Dr. Brian W. Hill, a fellowship-trained and board-certified orthopedic surgeon (*pictured left*).



Jupiter Medical Center is the first in the area to offer the Whipple procedure, a complex surgery offering hope to pancreatic cancer patients and performed by Dr. Shanel Bhagwandin, Surgical Oncologist (*pictured left*).

The volume of pulmonary procedures has increased by 2 percent with the addition of a CT Cone-guided robotic lung biopsy offering enhanced accuracy by providing real-time 3D imaging leading to better diagnosis of lung cancer with high safety. These are performed in one of our two hybrid operating rooms (*pictured right*).





We achieved a major milestone – the completion of our 500th Ion Robotic Bronchoscopy procedure. As one of the first in our region to introduce this technology, it allows our interventional pulmonology team (*pictured left*) within our Thoracic Surgery and Lung Center of Excellence to navigate to lung nodules with remarkable precision, helping diagnose complex conditions earlier and more accurately.



Jupiter Medical Center is also the first hospital in the Palm Beaches and Treasure Coast to complete a robotic-assisted MIDCAB (Minimally Invasive Direct Coronary Artery Bypass) procedure for the treatment of Coronary Artery Disease. This innovative surgery was performed by the team at Jupiter Medical Center led by Vivek Patel, MD, FACS, Cardiac Surgeon (*pictured left*). This procedure represents a significant advancement in the treatment of coronary artery disease, and places Jupiter Medical Center in the company of only a handful of programs in the state to offer this treatment.

The Johnny and Terry Gray Surgical Institute features an entirely revamped and enlarged Sterile Processing Department featuring state-of-the-art technology. Operating rooms are equipped with Indigo-Clean environmental disinfection technology that uses visible light to safely, automatically, and continuously, kill harmful bacteria and viruses, 24/7 in the air, and on hard and soft surfaces is installed in each operating room.

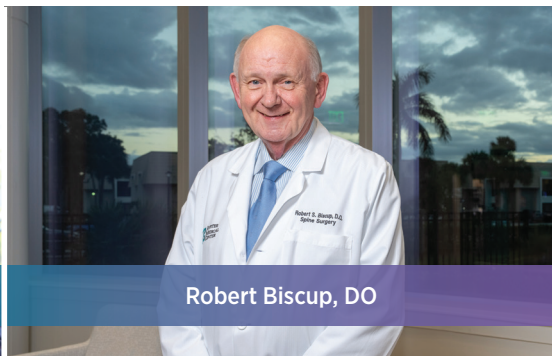

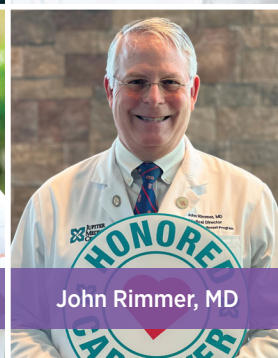
