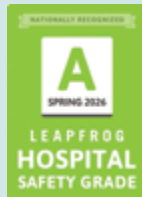

The Petrocelli Emergency Center at Jupiter Medical Center stands as one of the region's most advanced and trusted resources for urgent and life-saving care. Jupiter Medical Center has consistently been recognized by The Palm Beach Post's Community Choice Awards as having one of the best emergency rooms in the region.

Open 24/7 and designed to handle everything from minor injuries to complex, time-sensitive medical emergencies, every patient benefits from access to board-certified emergency physicians, highly trained nurses, and state-of-the-art, in-house diagnostic technology—tools that enable faster, more accurate evaluation and treatment.



Thanks to significant philanthropic support from numerous supporters, including gifts from the Attilio and Beverly Petrocelli Foundation and Joyce C. Fisher, Jupiter Medical Center opened its expanded Emergency Department in 2023.

This modernization included the opening of the Peter and Missy Crisp Fast Track Suite marking a transformative milestone – increasing capacity by 30 percent, adding 11 new treatment rooms and eight Fast Track bays – to care for patients with non-life-threatening conditions more quickly.

The Fast Track Suite (pictured top right) is designed to quickly treat patients with less complex medical needs, helping them move through the emergency department more efficiently while freeing critical resources for higher-acuity cases. This targeted approach has reduced wait times, improved patient flow, and elevated overall satisfaction for patients and families. Most importantly, it has strengthened our ability to meet growing community needs without compromising the quality or compassion of care.



The renovated space also includes expanded triage and patient areas, a more comfortable waiting environment for families, and a dedicated CT scanner.

Pediatric Emergency Care

In 2019, a generous gift established the Mastroianni Family Pediatric Emergency Department. This 6,300-square-foot, child-friendly unit is staffed 24/7 by pediatric emergency physicians and nurses and delivers specialized, compassionate care tailored to children from infancy through adolescence. The unit features eight pediatric treatment rooms, including an orthopedic room, dedicated family waiting areas, two pediatric triage rooms, medical equipment designed specifically for smaller patients, along with indoor play spaces that alleviate anxiety during emergencies.

COMMITTED TO ELEVATING CLINICAL EXCELLENCE

Access to a Neurologist After Hours

Our newly implemented tele-neurology carts provide real-time access to a neurologist, ensuring expert stroke evaluations for patients during overnight hours, weekends, and other after-hours times.

Dedicated IV Lounge

Featuring comfortable recliners and a television, the addition of a dedicated IV lounge provides a specialized space for patients receiving IV-only treatments. This enhancement helps ensure that private rooms remain available for those with higher-acuity conditions.

Obstetrical Emergency Department (OBED)

Jupiter Medical Center opened its dedicated OBED to provide immediate access to expert care for all obstetric women at 20 weeks gestation or greater through eight weeks postpartum. Whether it's preterm labor, hypertensive disorders or postpartum complications, our OBED is designed to handle emergencies with the urgency and expertise our patients and their families expect – improving outcomes and providing peace of mind. The volume of women treated stands steady at more than 230 patients per month.

Caring for our Caregivers

Thanks to the generosity of the Joyce Fisher Family, an upgrade of the Emergency Department's team member breakroom provides a more inviting and functional space with improvements that give our caregivers an enhanced environment to recharge and ultimately strengthen the compassionate care they provide to patients. The Joyce Fisher Family also generously provides each shift with a nourishing meal once a month.

Improved Access

The addition of a dedicated GE Revolution EVO CT scanner with AI-driven True Fidelity technology continues to significantly improve access for our patients who require this type of test. Having this technology in our Emergency Department is extremely important when it comes to a diagnosis and reducing or eliminating delays in testing. This CT scanner plays a vital role in elevating clinical excellence and ensuring our team can respond rapidly when every second matters.



Reduced Anxiety for our Smallest Patients

We understand how unnerving it can be for children who need emergency care, and thanks to the generosity of philanthropic supporters like Nicklaus Children's Health Care Foundation and its Golden Cub Ambassadors Club we are able to provide toys, interactive games, and kid-sized furniture to help reduce anxiety. These new and innovative items – such as iPads with a subscription to Disney+, portable ceiling and wall projectors for exam rooms, busy boards and a sensory tower for patients with sensory processing disorders – provide a welcome distraction for our pediatric patients while alleviating anxiety and allowing caregivers to provide excellent care.

Our Team-Based Approach Saves Lives

At Jupiter Medical Center, our Emergency Department (ED) and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) providers, working in close partnership with our Cardiac Catheterization (Cath) Lab, are making meaningful strides in reducing door-to-balloon times for STEMI (heart attack) patients. Every minute matters in these cases, and our shared commitment to speed, coordination, and clinical excellence is making a real difference.

By leveraging early EKG transmission directly from the field and the Stryker Emergency Care LifeNet CARE application, our teams can activate the Cath Lab before the patient arrives. This early recognition allows us to mobilize quickly and prepare for immediate intervention.

What truly drives our success is a team-based approach. From EMS to the ED to the Cath Lab, every team member plays a critical role in ensuring seamless patient flow and rapid treatment. Through streamlined protocols, continuous communication, and the use of the latest technologies, we're minimizing delays and maximizing outcomes.

Due to this collaborative effort, Jupiter Medical Center continues to be the premier destination for emergency and cardiovascular care in South Florida.
