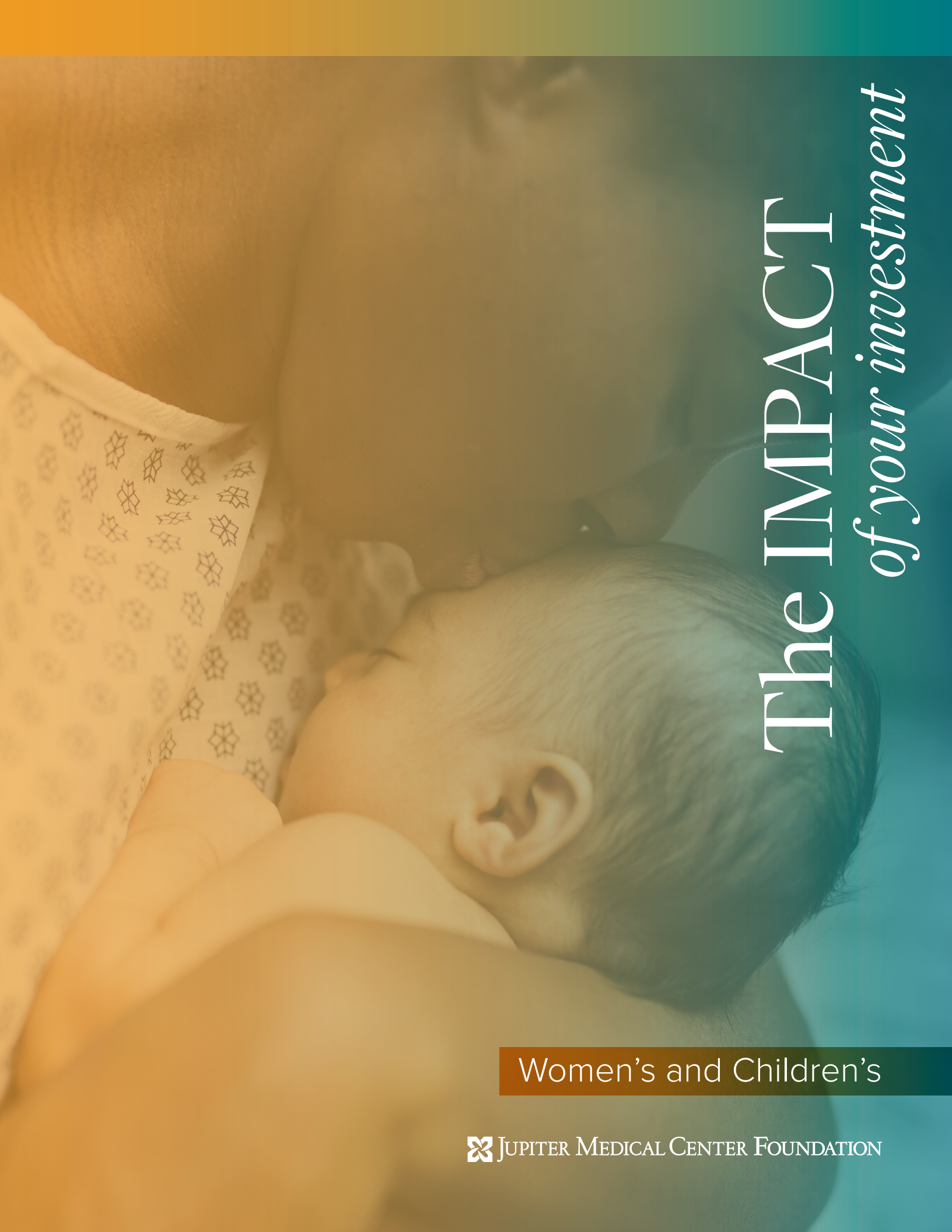

The extraordinary support of donors has transformed a shared vision into a state-of-the-art environment where expert, compassionate care is delivered in a setting designed to feel welcoming, calm, and comforting—like home.

Women who deliver at Jupiter Medical Center receive a personalized birthing experience in our modern, spacious suites, alongside the assurance of 24/7 laborists who collaborate seamlessly with personal physicians for optimal care. Enhanced by advanced monitoring technologies, comprehensive pain management protocols, and National Safe Sleep Certification that promotes safe infant-sleeping practices, the program reflects the profound impact of philanthropy on patient care.

Babies born as early as 30 weeks gestation are cared for in our **Level II De George Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU)**. Our specialized team provides round-the-clock care for these precious newborns, utilizing leading-edge monitoring equipment and supportive technologies to ensure they thrive and return home with their families.

Also made possible by philanthropy, the **Mastroianni Family Pediatric Emergency Department** established in 2019 provides care for more than 8,500 patients annually. Here families receive specialized emergency care that is close to home, comforting and accessible. This child-friendly environment includes eight private treatment rooms, pediatric triage stations to minimize wait times, an inviting family lounge, and indoor play areas to reduce anxiety. A dedicated pediatrician is on-site at all times, supported by a team specially trained to care for infants, children, and adolescents.

Margaret W. Niedland Breast Center

Created through Suzanne Niedland's deeply personal commitment to advancing imaging and early detection in our community, the **Margaret W. Niedland Breast Center** was inspired by her mother Margaret's courageous battle with breast cancer and a vision of care rooted in innovation, compassion, and access to the most advanced diagnostic tools available.

As a regional leader in comprehensive breast imaging and diagnostics, the center was thoughtfully designed with patient comfort at its core and integrates leading-edge technology within a warm, healing environment. The Center opened in 2015, performing 18,000 breast imaging studies and 12,400 general imaging procedures in its first year.

Today, the Niedland Center anchors Jupiter Medical Center's outpatient imaging services, having seen more than 112,000 patients in 2025. It serves not only those seeking specialized breast care, but also thousands of patients who rely on timely, accurate diagnostic services close to home.

Postpartum suites offer luxurious overnight accommodations for loved ones, while new moms enjoy spa-like amenities. Featuring a chef-curated menu and a range of exclusive, luxury amenities every detail has been meticulously crafted to ensure attentive, round-the-clock care from a dedicated team.



Award-Winning Maternity Care and Safe Sleep Education

The community's recognition of our commitment to maternity care and childbirth has resonated among Treasure Coast residents who voted us as the Best Maternity and Childbirth Center on the Treasure Coast. We proudly hold certification from the National Safe Sleep Hospital Certification Program, reflecting our dedication to implementing safe sleep practices within the hospital and promoting safer sleep habits at home. Our Safe Sleep initiative provides ongoing support and education for parents of infants up to one year, reaffirming our commitment to patient safety.

Obstetrical Emergency Department

In 2022, Jupiter Medical Center opened its Obstetrical Emergency Department established to treat women at 20 weeks gestation or greater through eight weeks postpartum. By ensuring 24/7 in-hospital obstetric coverage we are able to provide safer, faster, and more consistent care for pregnant and postpartum patients. At the same time, this program improves operational reliability, strengthens physician alignment, and enhances overall maternal safety metrics.

As surrounding hospitals have limited or closed their maternity units, Jupiter Medical Center consistently sees more than 200 patients per month in this department.

Unprecedented Demand for Obstetrics Services

This coming year, Jupiter Medical Center is on track to deliver more than 3,000 babies – a 70 percent increase since 2020 – requiring additional services for women and families who place their trust in us. We have grown into a leading destination for maternal and neonatal care.

In recent months, our program has experienced the highest delivery volume in Palm Beach County, and additional postpartum and OR space is essential to maintain safe, high-quality care. Meanwhile, there have been consistently low pediatric inpatient needs at JMC. To ensure we are allocating resources to meet the demands of the community, the De George Pediatric Inpatient Unit has been transitioned back to Obstetrics resulting in the addition of 12 more rooms for postpartum care, plus two additional operating rooms.

Committed to Pediatric Excellence

In 2025, the Level II De George Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) provided care to more than 290 patients. This unit opened in October 2019 thanks to the generosity of the Lawrence J. and Florence A. De George Charitable Trust, in partnership with the Nicklaus Children's Hospital/Nicklaus Children's Health Care Foundation. The 16-bed NICU enables Jupiter Medical Center to care for newborns as early as 30 weeks' gestation. Our commitment to pediatric excellence remains strong and with so many infants needing even higher levels of care, we continue to evaluate growth in this area.



Growth at the Margaret W. Niedland Breast Center

Philanthropy has guided the Center from the very beginning and continues to fuel its growth and impact thanks to donors like you.

Last fall, Jupiter Medical Center announced a fundraising goal of \$15 million to expand the Margaret W. Niedland Breast Center. To date, \$12 million has been raised toward that goal. This includes a transformational lead gift from Dorothy J. Thomson (pictured below), whose extraordinary generosity will be recognized through the naming of both the

Center's Healing Garden—a serene space for comfort and reflection—and the new main lobby.

We are also deeply grateful for generous gifts from Suzanne Niedland, which will be recognized through the naming of the Suzanne L. Niedland Atrium—a welcoming beacon of hope and healing for all who enter—and from Carol and Daniel Strickberger to name the new Phlebotomy Suite.

The expansion will add 13,000 square feet of advanced technology, including three CT scanners, a second MRI, expanded mammography, and a dedicated ultrasound biopsy room. These enhancements will increase patient capacity, reduce wait times, and support earlier, more precise diagnoses—ensuring patients receive timely, coordinated care in a comfortable and thoughtfully designed environment.



Recognized as a Breast Imaging Center of Excellence by the American College of Radiology, the Niedland Breast Center continues to invest in the latest industry-leading technology and techniques performed by a team of diagnostic breast imaging specialists and supporting clinicians to ensure a quality patient experience. They offer an array of screening and diagnostic services designed to detect breast anomalies quickly and accurately, and include:

- 3D Mammography • Ultrasound • Genetic Counseling and Testing • 3D Biopsy
- 3D Contrast-Enhanced Mammography • Breast MRI • Minimally Invasive Biopsy

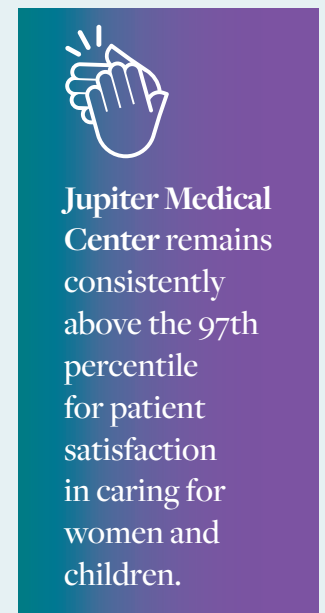

A suspicious finding on her mammogram led to same-day intervention by other Jupiter specialists who quickly scheduled a more specific diagnostic mammogram, followed by needle biopsy just days later to ensure a correct diagnosis. It was cancer. Today Cynthia is cancer-free thanks to the comprehensive care team at Jupiter Medical Center.

"What's great is that I know that if cancer comes back, I have this amazing team that going to get me through it again," Cynthia says. "I just don't worry about it. I do what I'm supposed to do, take my medications, and I know that if it comes back, I'll be in good hands."

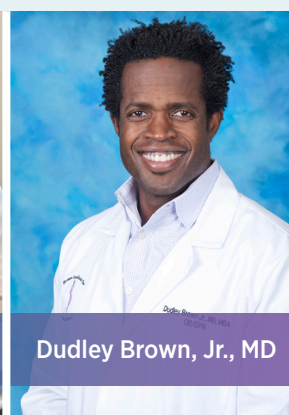


Honored Caregivers
